

SUNDAY SCHOOL UNIT I **QUARTERLY OVERVIEW**

Calls to service recorded in the Gospels of Mark and Luke are highlighted. We explore Paul's call to ministry with special attention to the Roman church. On Easter Sunday, we will examine Matthew's account of the resurrection.

UNIT II - THE SPREAD OF THE GOSPEL

Unit II, "The Spread of the Gospel," (four sessions) begins with Paul's introduction of himself to the Jewish and Gentile Christians living in Rome. Paul affirmed the call to salvation was to Israel and the Gentiles. This call to salvation is a call to life in the Spirit and involves new life in Christ.

The signs are all there in Exodus 3. Words can be found in a straight line horizontally, vertically, or diagonally. They may be read either forward or backward.




